Pre-K: Please label all school supplies with child's name

***Please bring these items to school when your child comes to have lunch with Mrs. Bailey. Thank you!**

*3"x5" file box (Beware! The nice ones that look like a "chest" do not seem to open far enough. They tend to close on little fingers.)

*100 – 3"x5" unlined white file cards

*Small child size shoebox – regular opening lid or attached lid; at least 8" long (we will be cutting these – nothing fancy)

*Extra set of clothing – underwear, socks, slacks, and summer shirt. Please try to keep the color neutral to blend with whatever your child may be wearing if the need arises. Try to size large. This extra set will be sent home in December to be recycled into their wardrobe and replaced by something perhaps slightly larger for January through June.

*A large sweater or sweatshirt with a total front opening to fit over winter clothing. This is to remain at school at all times on your child's hook. Please put your child's name on the tag so it can be easily identified.

*Pack of inexpensive napkins or a box of gallon size Zip-loc baggies

*Box of large Crayola washable markers – classic colors

*Box of tissues.

Daily Concerns:

Wear safe shoes for the playground. Shoes must have a closed toe and a non-slip sole. They need to be secured tightly to the foot for safety reasons. I would prefer that this type of shoe be worn to and from school so that time is not taken from recess waiting for children to change footwear. I strongly discourage and would appreciate NO shoes that light up, have Velcro, zipper or elastic style closures. These new styles cause distractions and usually do not hold up well. Even closed-toe secured sandals have an uncomfortable habit of collecting mulch from our play area and are also discouraged.

After-School Care (ASC): Please label all school supplies with child's name

Pre-K and K students going to ASC need the following supplies:

Lunch and an afternoon snack each day

Small blanket and small pillow

Small stuffed animal to sleep with

Box of zip-lock sandwich bags

Box of #2 Pencils

Package of 2 inch erasers

Please assume that we will be going outside to play every day and supply your child with proper outerwear. Our recess time is early and although the weather report calls for high temperatures it is often still very cold in these early hours.

When your daughter wears a dress, a pair of shorts underneath is encouraged. We have a climbing structure.

Snack box – Lunch box or bag no larger than 8"x7"x10" – needs to fit into our cubbies. Children remaining for After-School Care should have a separate box or bag for lunch.

Plastic cup or mug - **with name** - to be washed and returned in snack box daily. Please no lids, sippers, or straws. The cup should be no more than 5 inches high and easily gripped by your child's hand.

Daily snack – crackers and fruit, yogurt, cheese sticks, veggies, dips, etc. with juice or milk. Drinks may be sent in plastic bottles, which will be poured into cups. Pre-packaged juice pouches or boxes are acceptable. Water will always be available. Something healthy, keep the quantity small. Please no cookies, cake, pudding, Jello or candy. Be aware of sugar and food color quantities. Please, no yogurt in tubes. Remember a napkin and any necessary utensils.

No Backpacks –Please allow your child to look forward to this purchase as she/he moves up to kindergarten. Those children who will be staying for After-School Care at Grace may bring a backpack to house their snack box, lunch box, and folder (provided by the school) and other items desired for After-School Care. Upon arrival your child will remove the snack box and folder, then deposit the backpack and lunchbox in the After-School Care room.
