• If the child is in 4th through 6th grade, parents should refer to FACTS SIS for the assignments. Parents can make arrangements to pick up books for the assignments on FACTS SIS or ask that they be sent home with a sibling, if they desire. Additional work will be sent home the day they return to school, and the student will have a reasonable amount of time to make up the work. Assistance will be given to make sure the student understands the material. This may include working during recess and study hall upon their return. If a student is out for an extended number of days and a parent requests work, the teacher will use their discretion and send home what they feel is appropriate.

Homework Policy When a Student Knows in Advance He/She Will be Absent:

• Students will be given a reasonable amount of time to make up work when they return to school following a vacation. Students in grades 4-6 may choose to take their books, check their assignments on FACTS SIS and complete any work while on vacation. Any additional work will be given upon their return. If a student has difficulty with the material they will have time upon their return to get assistance. This may include working during study halls or recess.

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Bible- Jones

Students will take a Catechism test and a verse test each Friday. Both will have a fill in the blanks format

Each student needs an ESV Bible and a Catechism book. Catechism books are \$1.50 if you need a new one.

Our curriculum focuses on the origins of Scripture, and explores stories and principles from the Old and New Testament.

Chapel messages will be on video this year. Our theme is the Tabernacle.

Grammar - Musselman

Tests will be given at the conclusion of a unit and about midway for longer units. A complete preposition test will be given two times a quarter beginning the second quarter. A partial test for jingle paragraphs will be given every other week for the first quarter.

Writing - Jones

Institute for Excellence in Writing (IEW) will be used. It is an incremental format for rewriting paragraphs and writing original paragraphs and essays. Subjects for writing will relate to history, science or Bible. We will also focus on the 6+1 Traits of Writing.

Spelling/Vocabulary - Musselman

Wordly Wise list - <u>spelling test</u> on the first Wednesday, <u>vocabulary test</u> on the following Wednesday Tests occur every other week on Wednesdays. A Quizlet access code is in the front of your child's workbook. This is an interactive website with games to help study vocabulary.

Reading - Jones

basal reader stories, novel units, book clubs, comprehension skills, workbook pages and poetry memorization.

Math - Musselman

Fact practice - XtraMath drill for the first half of the year, I expect students to practice 3 times a week. Later students will work measurement facts and multi-step facts on paper.

New concept lesson

Written practice is homework if a student does not complete it in class

Fact Drill practice is also homework

Cumulative tests over the textbook lessons will be given about every 10 days. I will take a grade using XtraMath every 2 -3 weeks.

Science - Musselman

The first several guizzes will be open book using notecards. There are one to three per chapter. Tests are given at the end of each chapter.

Course content will begin with recycling and then chapter 11 on the respiratory system.

History - Jones

Review of American History, from American exploration and colonization through World War II. There is one quiz and one test per chapter.

Projects, review games, timelines, maps, and worldview discussions.
