- GCS students and their guests must emphasize modesty, neatness, cleanliness, and appropriateness in clothing choices.
- Especially for dances, pick an outfit you can have fun in! Jumping up and down is a regular occurrence at our dances, and if you cannot do that in your outfit safely and modestly, you should pick another outfit.
- When in doubt . . . don't, or at the very least bring your outfit (or a current picture of you wearing it) to school for approval by the HS Principal or his/her designer. Female staff will review female attire. Male staff will review male attire.
- Males should wear appropriate:
 - o Suit jackets or vests,
 - o Full button-up shirts (tucked in) with a tie, or mock/turtleneck shirts,
 - o Dress pants with belt, and
 - Safe & appropriate shoes & socks.
 - Seniors at graduation and Homecoming Court Members must wear dress shoes & socks
- Females should wear dresses that match the below guidelines:
 - O No revealing necklines or open slits in the top of the dress.
 - o Dresses must have straps.
 - o No see-through, tight, or clingy dresses.
 - o The back must be at or higher than the bra line.
 - O The highest point of a dress's hemline, slits, or openings must be no shorter than 4" from the back of the knee.
 - Safe & appropriate shoes.
 - Seniors at graduation and Homecoming Court Members must wear dress shoes that are safe (no higher than 2" heels).
