1. Have proper heading in first box on top right:

Example:

Name	Mary Math
Class	Prealgebra 8/7 (or Algebra I)
Date	8/28/13
Lesson #	L1.7 #1-35 odd

★ Note: Mrs. Yeomans also asks you to write #missed, ratio, percent, and AC grade. See classroom expectations sheet for example.

2. Be done in pencil.
3. Have original problems copied down.
4. Formulas must be written first and the following format used. If the formula is used for more than one problem in a section, the formula may be written once at the top of the section.  
$$A = \frac{1}{2} bh$$
$$= \frac{1}{2} (3)(4)$$
$$= 6 \text{ feet or ft. Do not use the symbol. Ex. } 2'$$
5. All work must be shown. This includes labeling entries such as feet, inches, etc. as well as boxing or circling intermediate and final answers.
6. Word problems should always identify the unknown or unknown variables (i.e., let  $x = 5$ )
7. Be neat. Each problem must be numbered with no more than two problems across the top of the page. Skip a line between problems.
8. Check problems in red ink.
9. Correct work in pencil in a section labeled "Corrections" either on a separate page or at the end of the paper if there is adequate room. The Math Standards need to be followed. No work is to be done in the margins.
