**The GCS Dress Code Standards include modesty, appropriateness, neatness, and cleanliness. We rely on our partnership with families to uphold our standards and guidelines by assisting students with making wise decisions about their appearance (clothing & grooming) at school and GCS events.**

### **Preschool - 6th GRADE STUDENT DRESS CODE**

If students arrive dressed inappropriately, they will be instructed to correct the situation. If unable to comply, he/she will be asked to call a parent to bring clothing to the school or wear alternative clothing provided by the school. The school administration will serve as the final authority in interpreting and enforcing this dress code.

	<b>WEAR</b>	<b>DON'T WEAR</b>
<b>Pants, Capris, Sweat Pants, Leggings or Jeggings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Items that are properly fitted and sized.</li> <li>● If tight-fitting, skinny-style, leggings or jeggings, they must be worn with a looser style dress code-appropriate shirt or blouse which completely covers the "seat" (except for Preschool-3rd grade).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Ragged, torn, frayed, with holes</li> <li>● pajama pants</li> </ul>
<b>Shorts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Shorts/skorts should be mid-thigh or longer.</li> <li>● Shorts may be worn throughout the year at the parent's discretion, please wear weather-appropriate attire.</li> </ul>	
<b>Shirts and Blouses</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All tops should not expose the midriff and should not be tight or form-fitting.</li> <li>● Sleeveless shirts and blouses must cover undergarments.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Spaghetti strap, off-the-shoulder, strapless or open-back shirts</li> <li>● See-through or sheer shirts</li> <li>● Crop top</li> </ul>
<b>Dresses, Skirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Dresses or tunics which follow the shirt and blouse guidelines and fall mid-thigh or longer.</li> <li>● Shorts, tights or leggings should be worn underneath.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Spaghetti strap, sheer, strapless or open back dresses</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● For safety reasons, athletic-style shoes are strongly recommended because of daily outside play.</li> </ul>	
<b>Field Trips</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● GCS field trip polo, khaki pants/shorts or skirts.</li> <li>● The teacher may make exceptions when the nature of the field trip is not conducive to this outfit.</li> </ul>	
<b>Other</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Hair should be a natural color and neatly groomed.</li> <li>● Ear piercing is acceptable.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Tattoos, body and facial piercings</li> <li>● Hats, caps, or hoods should not be worn in the buildings.</li> </ul>
