FORMAL/SEMI-FORMAL ATTIRE GUIDELINES

- GCS students and their guests must emphasize neatness, cleanliness, and appropriateness in clothing choices.
- Especially for dances, pick an outfit you can have fun in! Jumping up and down and raising arms are a regular occurrence at our dances, and if you cannot do these actions in your outfit and remain within the dress code guidelines, you should pick another outfit.
- If students are not sure that they meet the guidelines, they may wear their attire to show to the designated GCS employee or show that individual photos or a video that they have stored on their personal electronic device.

The photos or video should depict the student wearing the attire from all sides.

- Males should wear appropriate:
 - Suit jackets or vests,
 - Full button-up shirts (tucked in) with a tie, or mock/turtleneck shirts,
 - Dress pants with belt, and
 - Safe & appropriate shoes & socks.
 - Seniors at graduation and Homecoming Court Members must wear dress shoes & socks
- Females should wear dresses that match the below guidelines:
 - No revealing necklines or open slits at the top of the dress.
 - Bustline must be entirely and fully covered at all times, even while dancing or other movement.
 - No see-through, tight, or clingy dresses.
 - The back of the dress must be above the natural waistline at the navel.
 - The highest point of a dress's hemline, slits, or openings must be no more than 2 inches above the top of the knee.
 - Safe & appropriate shoes.
 - Seniors at graduation and Homecoming Court Members must wear dress shoes that are safe (no higher than 2" heels)
