Snacks:

Lunch:

Lunch will be eaten in the classroom this year. Please try to pack non-microwavable lunches as much as possible as there is one microwave for the entire class.

Health Precautions:

Hand sanitizer is provided in the classroom and in hallway dispensers, and students are reminded to use it throughout the day. Your child is also welcome to keep a bottle inside his or her desk.
